Bring us your peanut butter today!

Peanut butter is an excellent source of protein with a stable shelf life and is not cost effective for purchase by our local food banks. Every year the local Unions partner with the Labor Agency and Emergency Food Network to bring thousands of pounds of peanut butter to families in need.

The Emergency Food Network (EFN) distributes the donated peanut butter through its network of local food banks. In May, just before most school lunch programs are suspended for the summer months, EFN stocks their shelves with the donated jars. This event helps ensure children are getting a good source of protein during the summer.

What you can do:

- Bring a jar (or more) of peanut butter to the February, March, April, and May Labor Council Delegate meetings!
- Ask the members of your Locals to bring jars of peanut butter to your membership meetings. Remind them to please buy their peanut butter at a Union grocery store!
- Turn in all peanut butter donations to the Labor Council no later than the **May 11th** Delegate meeting!
